### Scottish Culinary Team - Requirements and Specification

#### Mandatory Requirements

All Scottish Culinary Team members must be fully paid members of Scottish Chefs; the National Society recognised by World Chefs the accrediting body of International Culinary Competitions.

#### Personal Specification and Requirements

1. Minimum age of 21 years with no less than 5 years culinary and cooking experience
2. Previous experience of culinary competitions is desirable
3. Any specialism e.g. Pastry, Cold Display or Food Art would be an advantage
4. Attendance at all team practice sessions including fund raising dinners and support of sponsors promotional events
5. Attendance at group photograph session
6. Attendance at Opening and Closing Ceremony of Culinary World Cup
7. A current passport valid for a minimum of 6 months from November 2022
8. Valid travel insurance cover
9. Medical insurance cover
10. If required full vaccination for Covid-19

#### EXPOGAST - Culinary World Cup, Luxembourg, November 2022 (Dates to be advised)

The Culinary World Cup is held every 4 years at EXPOGAST in Luxembourg, only the top 32 National Culinary Teams taken from the World Rankings are eligible to compete. The team will compete on 2 competition days. Day 1 - present a menu for 110 covers in the Restaurant of Nations and Day 2 - present a Chefs Table for 12 covers. In addition, a Showpiece will also be presented. The duration of the trip will be approximately 8 days and all members must be available for that period therefore if selected they should at the earliest opportunity discuss their availability to travel with their current employer.

Training will be an ongoing part of the team's preparation for the competition and the final selection of the competing team of 6 chefs together with support team members will be made 3 months prior to the competition. The total numbers travelling to Luxembourg will be approximately 15 including Scottish Chefs Management and Team Logistical support.
